The Chairperson welcomed the members and initiated discussion on the syllabus for V semester. He apprised the members of the guidelines of the UGC and the CCE regarding approval of syllabus, and the recommended evaluation ratio for internal and external examinations. The members discussed in detail the various aspects presented before them and unanimously resolved the following:

3rd Year BA V semester consists of 2 papers paper-V -Contemporary Indian Economy and paper-VI -Quantitative Techniques.

In paper-V more emphasis on all topics should be with reference to their current status. Discussion of theoretical aspects is not expected.

In paper-VI Mathematical derivations and proofs are not required. Only applications are enough.

In each Semester 100 marks paper is divided into two parts.

- a. **60 marks** caters to **External** evaluation and
- b. **40marks** caters to **Internal** assessment.
2. 60 marks in External assessment is divided as
 - a. **20 marks** in **Section A** and
 - b. **40 marks** in **Section B**
3. 40 marks in Internal Assessment is divided as
 - a. 10 marks for Assignment,
 - b. 5 marks for Viva/Assessment,
 - c. 5 marks for Seminars,
 - d. 10 marks for Project work and
 - e. 10 marks for the Best of the two mid exams
4. The HOD has to prepare the list of Examiners and Paper Setters and will be submitted to the Academic Council.
5. The committee has approved the syllabus with **5 Units for each paper** i.e **paper-V and paper-VI in Semester V.**
6. The committee has approved the Model Question Paper for external exams - 60 marks and is divided as follows,

- a. In Section A, answer **any 5** out of 10 Questions. Each one carries **4 marks**, totaling to **20 marks**. From each Unit/Module 2 questions have to be selected.
 - b. In Section B, answer **all 5** questions. Each question has internal choice. Each question carries **8 marks** totaling to **40 marks**. Each question has to be selected from each unit/Module.
7. The committee has approved the Blue Print of the question paper. Question paper has to be designed in such a way that **24 marks have to be obtained from each unit/Module.**
 8. Modifications, if need be in the above resolutions, will be done by The HOD and the faculty members of the department.
 9. The committee has approved that all the above resolutions will be effective for **three years** i.e., 2019-20, 2020 -21, 2021-22 academic years.


