Minutes and Resolutions of Board of Studies Meeting

As per the instructions of the Principal the Department of Economics has conducted Board of Studies meeting to approve the syllabi for 3rd and 4th Semesters and to re-Approve the 1st, 2nd, 5th and 6th Semesters in the subject of Economics under the chairmanship of **Dr.B.Subha**, In charge of the Department of Economics on 2nd December 2021. The above committee members have attended the meeting to approve the syllabus for the academic year 2021-22.

The Chairperson welcomed the members and initiated discussion on the syllabus for I, II, III, IV, V & VI semesters. She apprised the members of the guidelines of the UGC and the APSCHE regarding approval of syllabus, and the recommended evaluation ratio for internal and external examinations. The members discussed in detail the various aspects presented before them and unanimously resolved the following:

Agenda:

1. Approval of the new syllabus which was designed by Andhra Pradesh State Council for Higher Education for Semesters III & IV for the academic year 2021-22.
2. Re-approval of APSCHE syllabus for Semesters I & II for the academic year 2021-22
3. Re-approval of Krishna University syllabus for Semesters V & VI for the academic year 2021-22
4. Approve the Student Evaluation procedure and split- up of CIA & SEE.
5. Approval of Model Question papers and Blueprint
6. Approval of list of paper setters and examiners
7. Approval of Financial Marketing as a Skill Development course for Semester III
8. Approval of Bridge course for I BA students before commencement of Semester I
9. Any other item with the approval of the chair.

Discussion:

1. The University Representative and members asked about the changes made in the credits of courses, and framework of the courses. The chairman and faculty members explained the changes made in the courses.
2. The members discussed about the semester I & II and semester V & VI for reapproval.
3. The members discussed about the feasibility for the implementation of proportion and split-up of 40% Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIA) and 60% Semester End Evaluation (SEE).
4. Broadly discussed about Question paper model and Blueprint
5. The members of the department identified subject experts and prepared the list of Paper setters as well as Examiners for Semester End Examinations.
6. Discussed about Skill Development courses designed by the Andhra Pradesh State Council for Higher Education for semester III.
7. Discussed the use of recollection of previous knowledge through Bridge Course.

Resolutions:

1. It is resolved to approve the course structure and Syllabi for III & IV Semester from the Academic year 2021-22 onwards. These are no notable changes in syllabi of the courses.
In paper- III more emphasis on all topics should be with reference to current status. discussion of theoretical aspects is not expected.
In paper- IV Mathematical derivations and proofs are not required. Only applications are enough.
2. It is resolved to continue the same syllabus of I, II, V and VI which is already approved in the year of 2020-21.
3. It is resolved to approve the Student Evaluation Policy and Procedure and split-up of 40% & 60%
4. It is resolved to follow the blueprint in the preparation of question papers without any deviations
5. It is unanimously resolved to approve the list of Question paper setters and Examiners
6. It is resolved to approve Financial Marketing as a Skill Development Course for Semester III with three modules.
7. It is resolved to approve syllabus of bridge course with five modules and should complete before commencement of semester I.
