Affordable Training for Proficiency (Training on Medicinal plants, Mushroom cultivation, stalls during consumer awareness week, Training on Clown fish breeding, vermicompost and Fish pond maintenance)</p> <p>3. Energy conservation (water/power/fuel/wild life conservation) Solar power panels are installed during 2016-17. This step helps to reduce the electricity bills drastically. With rain harvest pits ground water level in the campus increased and college ground is covered with greenery.</p> <p>4. Environment protection by arranging of Vermicompost units in the college premises , creating awareness on Geo-tagging of plants, medicinal plants)</p> <p>5. Awareness on Nutrition food by Aquaculture in the college premises .</p> <p>6. Extended facilities to differently abled students, Gym facility is made available to our students at a minimum price of Rs.100 per month and free for players.</p> <p>7. This facilitates to run four lectures at a time in different subjects to different colleges.
