The Credit Base and Choice System is on part with the system followed by U.K, Germany and USA etc., countries. It means that the student can choose Mathematics, Music and Dancing. I am very happy to give this opportunity to express my views regarding the CGPA that is called Credit Grade Point Average and SGPA i.e., Session Grade Point Average. Here, Grade Point multiplied with Respective marks, divided by total of Grade Points..

One Credit for Semester is in equal to One hour of Teaching.
UGC 10 points Grade System as follows:

Marks	Points	Grading
90-100	10	Outstanding 'O'
75-89.5	9	A + Excellent
60-74.9	8	A Very Good
55-59.9	7	B + Good
50-54.9	6	B Above Average
45-45.9	5	C Average

For Example: A student of EHP in B.A Group is having the following marks in Group subject. His CGPA calculate as follows:

Subject	Marks	Credits
Economics	9	4
History	8	4
Political Science	7	4

 \text{CGPA} &= \text{Total Marks} / \text{Total Credits} \times 100 \\
 &= \text{Eco Marks} \times \text{Credits} + \text{His} \times \text{Credits} + \text{Politics Marks} \times \text{Credits} \\
 &= 9 \times 4 + 8 \times 4 + 7 \times 4 \\
 &= 36 + 32 + 28 = 96 \quad \text{Total Marks: 96} \quad \text{Total Credits: 12} \\
 &= 96/12 \times 100 = 8 \quad \therefore \text{CGPA} = 8

Respected Principal and colleagues, today's workshop I have got an opportunity to explain CLUSTER pattern in Semester –VI.

7th paper of each of the domain specific subjects will be a domain related elective. More than one elective may be offered giving choice to students. The electives may be of Domain specific applied or advanced i.e. specialization in nature. The number of electives may be decided by the University concerned keeping the feasibility of conduct of university examinations in view.

Applied Elective: It is desirable that around 25% of syllabus is taught by field experts. The college has to make such an arrangement.

8th paper of each of the domain specific subjects (2nd paper of semester VI) will also be an elective. The electives may be of Inter-domain Cluster, each cluster having three papers with or without project work or General in nature. The number of clusters may be decided by the University concerned keeping the feasibility of conduct of University examinations in view. It is desirable that around 25% of syllabus is taught by field experts.

Cluster: In the last semester, for paper-8 each domain subject has one elective totalling three papers for each student. Electives may be given as Clusters of three papers each for each subject. A student can opt for all the three papers of the same subject (Cluster stream) including or excluding project work for a wider learning experience. The student will not study the other two domain subjects for paper-8.

Out comes of the Work shop

- Uneven distribution of work in V & VI semesters. The work in Semester VI has increased by 15 hours/week in each department(Group Subjects)
- The Language Departments in Semester IV has lost their complete work. Hence the work Load of subjects like Communication, Soft Skills etc may be considered as official work for Teachers of the Languages.
- Recruitment of extra faculty due to increase in work load with regard to Cluster Electives.
- Providing additional accommodation and infrastructural facilities to students of Cluster Electives.
- In rural colleges availability of faculty is difficult task. Example: Communication Skills, Analytical Skills, Computer skills etc.,

** Applied Elective: It is desirable that around 25% of syllabus is taught by field experts. The college has to make such an arrangement.

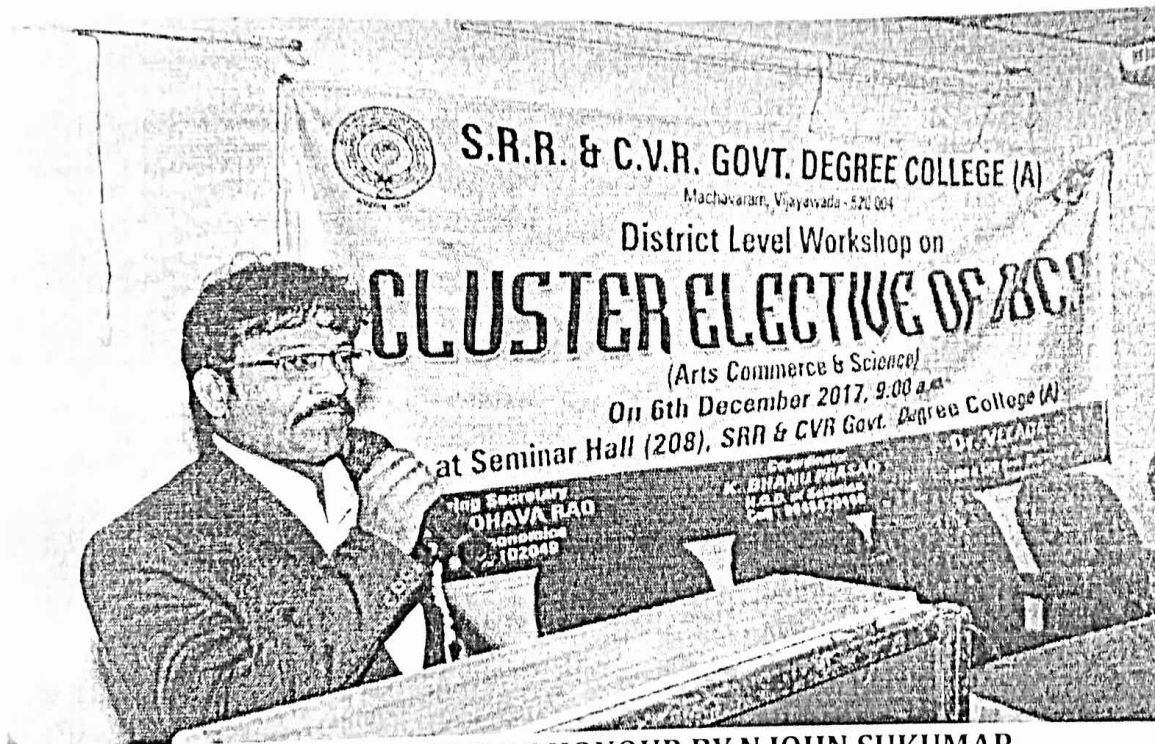

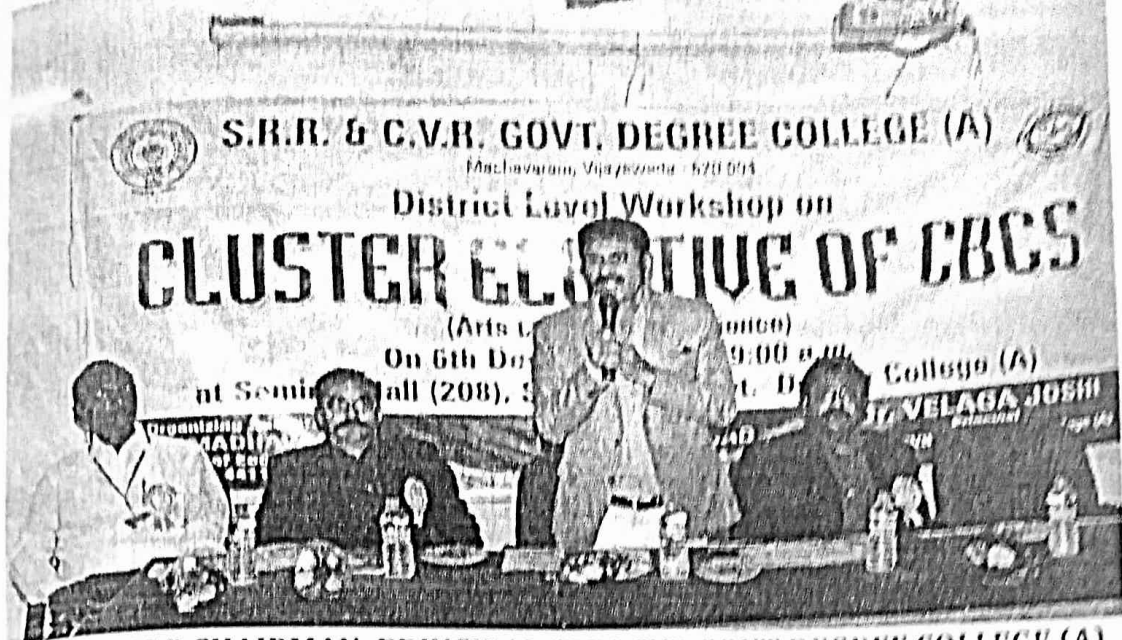

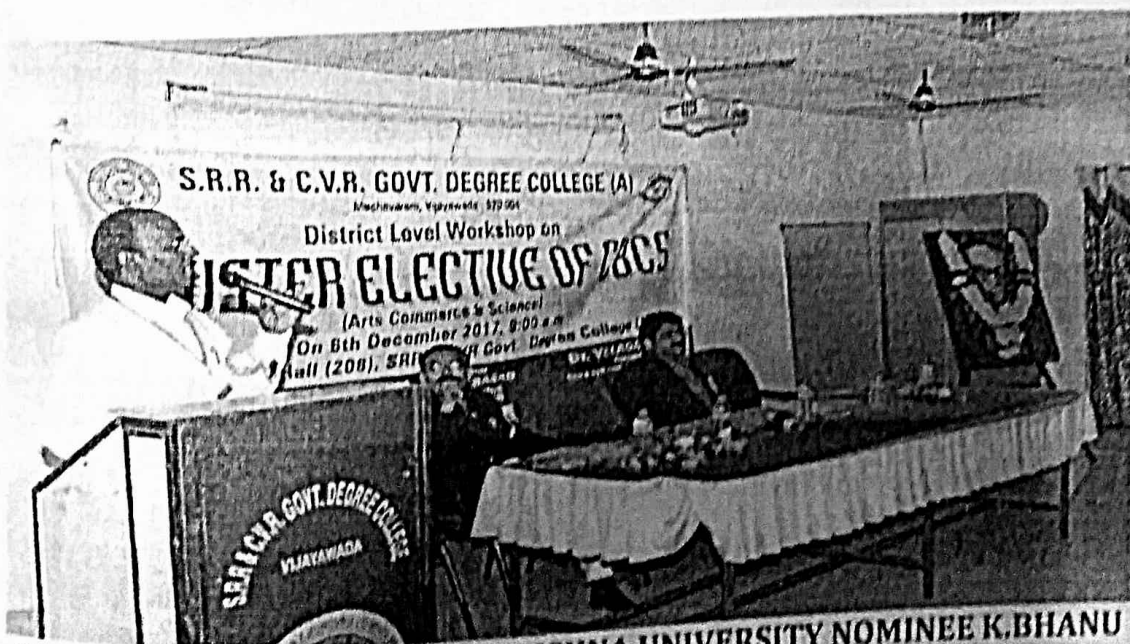
